



CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

ABSTRACT SUBMISSION IS NOW OPEN

The Scientific Chairpersons cordially invite authors to submit abstracts for the digital poster exhibition at the 13th Benefit User Meeting in Düsseldorf, Germany. Abstracts for both research and clinical posters on the topic of skeletal anchorage in the palate are welcomed.

Kindly note that the deadline for abstract submissions is **February 29, 2024**. Please ensure that your abstract is in PDF format and send it to Prof. Dr. Wilmes at wilmes@med.uni-duesseldorf.de. Following the submission, you will receive an email acknowledgment confirming the receipt of your abstract.

ABSTRACT GUIDELINES

- Abstract text is limited to 350 words
- Abstracts must be submitted in English
- Figures, tables and illustrations should not be included in the abstract
- Each abstract can only accommodate up to five authors
- Please note that only abstracts submitted by authors who have fully paid their congress registration fee by April 15, 2024, will be considered for inclusion in the final poster exhibition. It is essential to ensure that the registration fee is settled before the specified deadline to guarantee the inclusion of your abstract.

Please structure your abstract as follows:

- **TITLE:** In capitals (40 words maximum, excluding spaces). Do not use abbreviations.
- **AIM:** An introductory sentence indicating the objectives and purpose of the poster.
- **MATERIALS AND METHOD:** A description of the methodology.
- **RESULTS:** A summary of the results.
- **CONCLUSIONS:** A statement of the conclusions.

All submissions will undergo a review by the Scientific Chairpersons to determine acceptance. It is the responsibility of the submitting author to ensure that the abstract is accurate and well-written. Notifications regarding the acceptance or rejection of abstracts will be communicated via email to the corresponding author by **March 15, 2024**. Upon acceptance, the poster must be uploaded by **April 19, 2024**.

For the poster format, you have the option to submit either a PowerPoint slide (in wide screen 16:9 format), a PDF file, or a JPG image. Please make sure that the poster includes a picture of the main author.

The **Best Poster Presentation Award** will include a special prize and a certificate of recognition.
